

DESIGN, BUILD, AND LAUNCH A SMALL SATELLITE!

ARE YOU UP TO THE CHALLENGE?

(NO EXPERIENCE NECESSARY!)

A CanSat is a small simplified satellite which is the size of a pop can. The challenge is to fit all the major satellite subsystems - power, computer, sensors, communications system, and science experiments - into this minimal volume.

The CanSat is launched by rocket (or dropped by drone) up to an altitude of approximately one kilometre. It conducts its mission as it descends, then you analyse the data which was collected.

The CanSat Design Challenge is seeking teams of high-school students from across Canada to join the competition in Autumn, 2026. Form a team at your secondary school. Design it, build it, then join us for the launch campaign in Spring, 2027!
